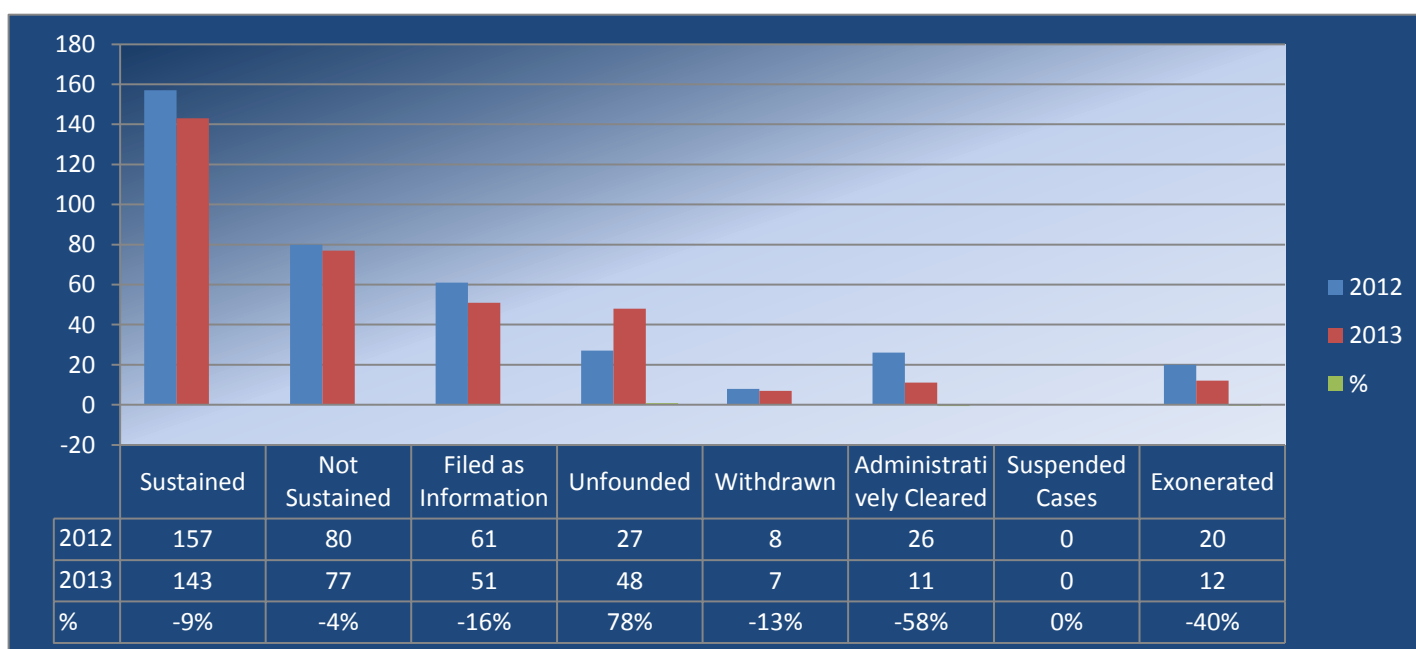


Internal Affairs Allegations by Findings

Case Classification

- Sustained: The allegation is supported by sufficient evidence
- Not Sustained: Insufficient evidence either to prove or disprove the allegation
- Exonerated: Incident complained of occurred but was lawful and proper
- Unfounded: Allegation is false or not factual
- Withdrawn: Case withdrawn by complainant
- Suspended Case: Case closed due to extended delay of contact with complainant subject or witness:
ie. . .Delay may be due to Military Leave, Illness or not able to make contact.
- File as Information: Case is filed as information only
- Administratively Cleared: Case closed due to the subject employee retiring, resigning or in the instance of his/her death prior to the conclusion of an investigation
