## **Homicide Investigation**

The Birmingham Police Department reports that detectives are conducting a homicide investigation. The incident occurred Friday, May 29, 2015 in the 2800 block of Avenue F.

The victim has been identified as:

**Lillie Rogers, B/F, 43, of Birmingham, Alabama**

On Friday, May 29, 2015 around 9:40 p.m. West Precinct officers responded to the listed location on a person shot. Upon arrival, officers observed the victim lying on the ground in the front yard suffering from what appeared to be a gunshot wound to the head area. The victim was pronounced deceased at the scene by Birmingham Fire and Rescue.

Our preliminary investigation revealed that the incident stemmed from a domestic situation between the victim and her boyfriend. According to a witness, family members' related to the victim came to the scene and supposedly got into a physical altercation with the victim's boyfriend which led to the victim being shot. Several people were transported to the administration building for questioning. Also, one person has been detained from the scene. This is an ongoing homicide investigation and additional information will be released as it becomes available.
