Homicide Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department reports that detectives are conducting a homicide investigation. The incident occurred Friday, July 31, 2015 in the 2100 block of Pike Road.

The victim's has been identified as: Chrystol Moore B/F 37 years of age of Birmingham.

On Friday, July 31, 2015, at approximately 10:20 p. m. West Precinct officers responded to the listed location on a deceased female call. Upon arrival, responding officers found the victim inside a residence suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. The victim was pronounced dead at the scene. Officers found the suspect, Mathew Moore B/M 80 years of age of Birmingham, sitting at the kitchen table and took him into custody.

Our preliminary investigation revealed that the victim and suspect who is believed to be the victim's father were involved in a verbal altercation because the suspect wanted the victim to purchase alcoholic beverages for him and she refused. It was at this time that the suspect shot the victim, his daughter. The victim was pronounced deceased at the scene. There are several witnesses who were able to tell investigators what lead up to the victim's murder. The suspect has been charged with Murder and given a \$40,000 bond. Moore is currently being held in the Jefferson County Jail.
