Homicide Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department reports that detectives are conducting a homicide investigation. The incident occurred Wednesday, April 6, 2016 in the 500 block of Huron Street Wylam.

The victim's name is being withheld pending next of kin notifications.

On Wednesday, April 6, 2016 around 6:49 am, officers from the West Precinct responded to the listed location on a person shot. Upon arrival, officers observed a Chevy S10 sitting in the middle of the street still running. Officers observed the victim sitting in the driver's seat suffering from what appeared to be multiple gunshot wounds to the body. Birmingham Fire and Rescue pronounced the victim deceased.

Investigators believe the victim might have known the shooter based on evidence found at the scene. Witnesses stated they heard several gun shots and observed a black male dressed in all black running from the vehicle. This is an ongoing investigation and information will be forwarded as it becomes available
