Homicide Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department reports that detectives are conducting a double homicide investigation. The incident occurred Friday, March 31, 2017 in 3000 block of 15th Street Ensley.

The victims could not be identified.

Two unknown males

On Friday, March 31, 2017, around 10:50 p.m. officers from the West Precinct were dispatched to the listed location on a possible garage fire. Upon arrival, they observed a Nissan Altima in the alley engulfed in flames. Birmingham Fire and Rescue responded to the scene and extinguished the fire. While inspecting the vehicle, they found a badly burned body in the back seat of the vehicle and a badly burned body inside the trunk of the vehicle. While examining the bodies, it appeared both victims were shot. Neighbors in the area stated around 11:00 p.m., they heard a loud explosion, but was not sure if it came from the car or a gunshot.
