Homicide Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department reports that detectives are conducting a homicide investigation. The incident occurred on Tuesday, July 25, 2017 in the 4200 block of 10th Avenue Wylam.

The victim has been identified as:
Edward Davis, B/M, 26 of Birmingham

On Tuesday, July 25, 2017 around 9:45 pm, officers from the West Precinct responded to the listed location on a person shot. Upon arrival, officers observed the victim lying in the middle of the roadway suffering from multiple gunshot wounds to the body. Birmingham Fire and Rescue responded to the scene to provide aid. Unfortunately, the victim succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased.

Detectives learned the victim and his nephew were in the middle of the roadway and were standing chest to chest as if they were about to fight. The incident escalated into a physical altercation between the two and the victim's nephew pulled a firearm and fired multiple shots striking the victim multiple times. After shooting the victim the suspect fled the location on foot before officers arrived.

“A disagreement between an uncle and a nephew should have never ended this way.”
