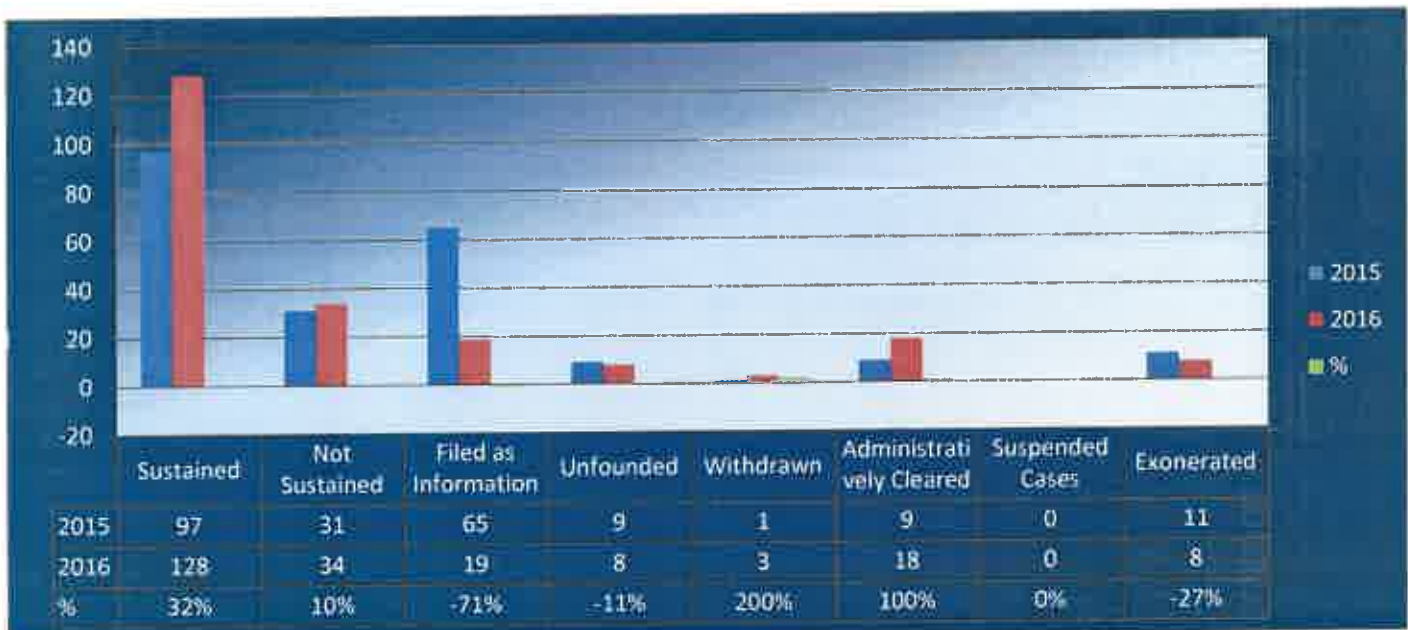


## Internal Affairs Allegations by Findings

| Exonerated               | 11         | 8          | -27%       |

## Case Classification

- Sustained:** The allegation is supported by sufficient evidence
- Not Sustained:** Insufficient evidence either to prove or disprove the allegation
- Exonerated:** Incident complained of occurred but was lawful and proper
- Unfounded:** Allegation is false or not factual
- Withdrawn:** Case withdrawn by complainant
- Suspended Case:** Case closed due to extended delay of contact with complainant subject or witness:  
*ie. . .Delay may be due to Military Leave, illness or not able to make contact.*
- File as Information:** Case is filed as information only
- Administratively Cleared:** Case closed due to the subject employee retiring, resigning or in the instance of his/her death prior to the conclusion of an investigation
