Homicide Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department reports that detectives are conducting a homicide investigation. The incident occurred on Monday, September 25, 2017 in 5900 block of Ellington Street.

The victim has been identified as:
Korderal Anderson, b/m, 29 of Birmingham

On Monday, September 25, 2017 around 9:53pm, officers of the West Precinct were dispatched to UAB West hospital on a gunshot victim in the emergency room. A few minutes after arriving to the hospital the responding officers were advised that the victim was pronounced deceased. Officers spoke with witnesses who brought the victim to the hospital and they were able to provide details pertaining to the incident location. West officers responded to the location in the 5900 block of Ellington Street.

Detectives learned the victim and the suspect are supposedly cousins and from what we understand there has been some ongoing feuding within the family. Allegedly, the victim and the suspect encountered one another at the suspect's daughter's apartment on Ellington Street and witnesses stated that they heard the two men exchange words and then heard a single gunshot. The suspect fired one shot striking the victim in the leg. The victim was transported to the hospital by personal vehicle. The suspect later turned himself in.
