Homicide Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department reports that detectives are conducting a homicide investigation. The incident occurred on Monday, August 28, 2017 in 1200 block of Gulfport Street.

The victim has been identified as:
Jamil Curry, b/m, 36 of Birmingham

On Monday, August 28, 2017 around 1:52pm, officers from the West Precinct were dispatched to the listed location on a male shot. When officers arrived they found the victim standing in the hallway suffering from a gunshot wound to the leg. Also, officers observed bullet holes to the residence which was the result of gun fire. The victim was transported to UAB Hospital where he was treated and later released.

Detectives learned the victim and the suspect had an argument and the suspect shot the victim in the leg. It appears the shooting stemmed from an incident involving money. The defendant was later arrested and charged with Assault 2nd degree and Discharging a Firearm Into An Occupied Dwelling but later made bond.

On October 3, 2017, the detective was notified by Jefferson County Coroner's Office that the victim succumbed to his injuries he received from the assault on August 28, 2017. The defendant is currently at large.
