Homicide Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department reports that detectives are conducting a homicide investigation. The incident occurred on Friday April 6, 2018, in the 900 block 1st Street North.

Victim: Unborn Baby Davis

Suspect: Unknown

On April 6, 2018, at about 8:00 PM, officers from the North Precinct were dispatched to 916 1st Street North on the report of a female being shot in the leg. The victim that was shot was transported to UAB Hospital by BFRS. The shooting victim was in fact shot in the abdomen and not the leg. The shot victim was pregnant when this incident occurred. The unborn baby did not survive and was taken to the Jefferson County Coroner's Office to determine if the mother's injuries resulted in the death of the unborn baby.

On April 9, 2018 the Jefferson County Coroner's Office deemed the unborn baby died as a result of the injuries obtained by the mother being shot. This case is now being investigated as a Homicide and Attempted Murder. The investigation is ongoing and updates will be provided as they become available.
