## **Robbery Investigation**

The Birmingham Police Department reports that detectives are conducting a robbery investigation. The incident happened on Thursday, August 16, 2018 near 77<sup>th</sup> Street South. Investigators need assistance from the public to identify the person in the attached photos and video.

Officers from the East Precinct responded to the location to investigate a report of a citizen that was robbed for their vehicle. Officers arrived to find that the suspect took the victim's 2016 Nissan, Sentra. The vehicle had tinted windows and a large dent on the roof. Other valuables were taken from the victim including credit and debit cards.

Investigators learned that the victim's credit and debit cards were used approximately an hour and a half later by an unknown black male. Investigators are referring to this subject in the surveillance photos and video as a person of interest in this investigation.
