Homicide Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department reports that detectives are conducting a homicide investigation. The incident occurred Saturday, November 10, 2018 at approximately 3:30 p.m.

The victim has been identified as:

Edward Tyurri Matthews, B/M, 29, of Birmingham, Alabama.

Officers from the East Precinct were called to the 500 block of Oporto-Madrid Boulevard North on a report of a person shot. When officers arrived, the victim was located in the front passenger seat of an SUV unresponsive. Birmingham Fire and Rescue arrived and transported the victim to U.A. B. Hospital for treatment. Officers found that the passengers of the SUV were involved in an altercation with subjects in a gray automobile on I-59 Northbound just before the victim was shot and the gray vehicle wrecked. Suspects from the gray vehicle fled the scene prior to officers' arrival.

On Sunday, November 11, 2018, investigators were notified that the victim had succumbed to his injuries.

Investigators have not established a clear motive in this case at this time. The investigation is still on going. No suspects are in custody.
