Robbery Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department reports that detectives have made an arrest in connection with a robbery investigation. The incident happened on Thursday, December 6, 2018.

At approximately 3:00 p.m., officers from the East Precinct responded to the Wells Fargo Bank located at 7524 1ST Avenue North to investigate a report of a robbery. Officers arrived to find that the suspect entered the business and presented a note demanding money. The suspect left the store with an undetermined amount of money.

Robbery investigators developed leads that led them to a residence in the 200 block of 67TH Place North where the suspect was possibly hiding. Officers from the East Precinct along with detectives and members of the BPD SWAT team responded to the location where a large number of subjects were located inside the residence. Officers were able to remove all of the subjects from the residence which included the suspect from the Wells Fargo Bank robbery.

The suspect has been identified as:

Roger Lee, B/M 41, of Birmingham, Alabama. A **Robbery 1ST Degree** warrant has been obtained against the suspect. The suspect is in the custody of the Jefferson County Jail. Three additional subjects were arrested on unrelated outstanding warrants. The three subjects are not believed to be involved in the Wells Fargo Bank robbery.
