Officer Involved Shooting Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department reports that an investigation into an officer involved shooting is underway. The incident occurred at 1:59 a.m. on Sunday, January 13, 2019, on the 900 block of 5TH Avenue North.

Officers were at the incident location to address vehicle burglaries when they encountered two suspects at a vehicle. The officers approached the suspects to investigate when one suspect produced a weapon and began to fire at the officers. Two Birmingham Police officers and one suspect were struck by gunfire. Both officers and one suspect were transported to U.A.B Hospital for treatment. A second suspect was taken into custody.

It was later learned that one of the injured officers succumbed to his injury and was pronounced deceased. The second officer remains in critical condition.

The fatally wounded officer has been identified as:

Sergeant Wytasha Carter, B/M, 44, of Birmingham, Alabama. Sergeant Carter has served with the Birmingham Police Department since 2011, where he has worked various assignments including West Precinct, HICOPP and Youth Services as a school resource officer. Carter was promoted to sergeant in February 2018.

Sergeant Carter began his law enforcement career in 2002 as a correctional officer with the Shelby County Sheriff's Office. Later that year he joined the Leeds Police Department where he served as an officer. In 2007, Sergeant Carter joined the Fairfield Police Department until transferring to the Birmingham Police Department.
