Robbery Investigation Update

The Birmingham Police Department reports that detectives have made 2 arrest in connection with a robbery investigation. The incident occurred at 9:58 a.m. on Sunday, January 6, 2019 at the Shell gas station located at 2320 University Boulevard. BPD investigators requested public assistance in identifying the suspects in surveillance photos.

The first suspect has been identified as:

Robert Jackson, B/M, 22, of Birmingham, Alabama. A **Robbery first degree** warrant has been obtained against the suspect. Investigators also obtained two additional **Robbery** first degree warrants on the suspect for the robbery of Subway at 803 20th Street South and a robbery from a person in the 1100 block of 23rd Street South. Both robberies occurred on January 7, 2019.

The second suspect has been identified as:

Solomon Minatee, B/M, 22, of Birmingham, Alabama. A **Robbery first degree** warrant has been obtained against the suspect.

The suspects were taken into custody by members of the Birmingham Police Department's Crime Reduction Team and are now in the custody of the Jefferson County Jail.
