Robbery Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department reports that detectives are conducting multiple robbery investigations. BPD investigators request assistance from the public in identifying the suspect in the attached surveillance robbery photo and videos.

The first robbery occurred on Thursday, March 7, 2019 at approximately 9:45 p.m. The suspect entered the Walgreens Store located at 9325 Parkway East and approached the register and showed the store clerk a handgun on his person. He then demanded money out of the register and cigarettes before leaving the scene with an undisclosed amount of money and the cigarettes.

The second robbery occurred on Friday, March 8, 2019 at approximately 6:58 p.m. The suspect entered the Family Dollar Store located at 6629 1st Ave North and approached the register to purchase an item. When the store clerk opened the register, the suspect revealed a handgun on his person and demanded money from the register. The suspect fled the scene with an undisclosed amount of money and was believed to be on foot.
