## **Robbery Investigation**

The Birmingham Police Department reports that detectives are conducting a robbery investigation. BPD investigators request assistance from the public in identifying the suspect in the attached surveillance robbery photos.

The robbery occurred on Friday, May 24, 2019 at approximately 4:21 p.m. when a suspect entered the UPS Store located at 1116 20<sup>th</sup> Street South. The suspect presented a handgun and demanded the workers give him the money from the cash registers. The suspect fled the location on foot after receiving the money. There were no injuries during the robbery.

The suspect wore a black hat, khaki pants, black shoes and a red bandana on his face. The suspect also had a portrait tattoo on his left forearm. **Investigators are hoping someone may recognized the tattoo.**
