Officer Involved Shooting

The Birmingham Police Department reports that an officer involved shooting investigation is underway. The incident occurred on Monday June 10, 2019 at approximately 9:53 p.m.

An East Precinct officer attempted to conduct a traffic stop in the 700 block of Georgia Road. The suspect failed to yield and a pursuit ensued. During the pursuit the suspect fired multiple rounds at the Officer striking the patrol unit which resulted in an exchange of gunfire. The pursuit ended at the intersection of McIntyre Road and Old Springville road as the suspect lost control of the vehicle resulting in a one car accident. The suspect fled from the scene on foot into a wooded area. The suspect is still believed to be in the area. The officer involved was transported to UAB hospital with minor injuries.

The Birmingham Police Department along with surrounding agencies are currently conducting a manhunt for the suspect.

The Birmingham Police department ask that all vehicular traffic steer clear of Old Springville Road between Echo Lake Lane and Surry Lane until further notice. This suspect is considered to be armed and dangerous.

The shooting investigation will be conducted by the Alabama Bureau of Investigation. Updates will be provided as they come available.
