Robbery Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department reports that detectives are conducting a robbery investigation. BPD investigators request assistance from the public in identifying the suspects in the attached surveillance robbery video and photos.

The robbery occurred on Wednesday, June 19, 2019 at approximately 10:07 p.m. at M&N Package Store located at 2330 Pearson Avenue. After two masked suspects approached the store one suspect acted as a lookout near the door as the other approached the clerk with a gun. The masked suspect forced the clerk to the register and began to take money. The masked suspects left the store after taking the money.

After reviewing the surveillance video, detectives observed two subjects without mask enter the business prior to the masked robber. The two unmasked subjects were not believed to be with the other suspects, but they began to grab items from the store once they realized the store was being robbed. Investigators would like to identify these unmasked subjects.

If there is anyone with information on the identity of the suspects, we ask that they contact BPD Robbery Detectives at 205-254-1753 or remain anonymous by contacting Crime Stoppers at 205-254-7777. If the tip to Crime Stoppers leads to an arrest, Crime Stoppers will provide a cash reward.
