Attempted Murder / Homicide Investigation Update

The Birmingham Police Department reports that detectives have obtained a third warrant in connection with an attempted murder / murder investigation. The incident occurred on Sunday, July 28, 2019 at approximately 9:47 p.m.

Officers from the East Precinct responded to a Shot Spotter call in the 7500 block of 67th Courtway South. While responding, officers received additional information that a person was shot near that location. Officers arrived and located a 4 year-old victim at 7535 67th Courtway South. The victim was suffering from an apparent gunshot wound and was transported to Children's Hospital for treatment by Birmingham Fire and Rescue.

Investigators learned that an altercation was taking place outside the apartment between the suspect and an adult male subject before shots were fired. While inside, the 4 year-old victim was struck by gunfire from the altercation outside the apartment.

On Wednesday, July 31, 2019, investigators received information that the 4 year-old had succumbed to her gunshot injury and was pronounced deceased by hospital staff. As a result, investigators have obtained an additional warrant against the suspect.

The suspect has been identified as:

Raymond Shine, B/M, 38, of Birmingham, Alabama. An **Attempted Murder** warrant has been obtained against the suspect. Investigators also obtained a **Certain Person Forbidden to Possess a Firearm** warrant against the suspect. In addition, investigators have obtained a **Murder** warrant against the suspect.

The victim has been identified as:

Jurnee Coleman, B/F, 4, of Birmingham, Alabama.

The warrant for attempted murder is for the shots fired at the adult male victim involved in the altercation with the suspect. The suspect is in the custody of the Jefferson County Jail.
