Robbery Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department reports that detectives are conducting a robbery investigation. Investigators request assistance from the public in identifying the suspects in the attached robbery photos.

At approximately 6:49 p.m. on Sunday, January 26, 2020, the suspect entered the Burger King restaurant located at 2700 University Boulevard. Upon entering, the suspect approached the counter as if he is going to make a purchase. While at the counter, the suspect waited for the register to open and reached across the counter to grab currency from the register. As the suspect fled the location 2 unknown suspects inside the suspects' vehicle pointed firearms at an employee. There were no injuries during the robbery.
