Homicide Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department reports detectives are conducting a homicide investigation. The incident occurred on Monday, January 11, 2021.

The victim has been identified as LaCorey Lashard McDonald, (31), B/M, of Alabaster, Alabama.

Just before 8:30 p.m., officers from East Precinct responded to St. Vincent's East Hospital after being notified of the arrival of a wounded gunshot victim. The victim, LaCorey Lashard McDonald was transported to the emergency room by private vehicle. McDonald sustained multiple gunshot wounds. McDonald succumb to his injuries and was pronounced deceased by St. Vincent Hospital staff.

Details are limited in this investigation. There are no suspects in custody.

This is Birmingham's 4th murder of 2021. The Birmingham Police Department adheres to FBI Uniform Crime Reporting guidelines set for all law enforcement agencies across the United States. FBI Uniform Crime Reporting guidelines do not require law enforcement agencies to include justifiable death investigations into the total homicide investigations counts.

The information is based on a preliminary and ongoing investigation, which continues to evolve as investigators interview witnesses, review physical and electronic records, and analyze forensic evidence. The Department's understanding of the facts and circumstances may change as additional evidence is collected and analyzed
