## **Homicide Investigation**

The Birmingham Police Department is conducting a double homicide investigation. The incident occurred on Thursday, April 29, 2021.

**The victims will be identified upon notification to the next of kin.**

At approximately 11:10 p.m., a North Precinct officer heard several gunshots near the 500 block of 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue West. Multiple shot spotter alerts then went off at 512 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue West. Officers were dispatched to the area to investigate. Upon arrival, officers observed two male victims lying unresponsive inside of a vehicle suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. Birmingham Fire and Rescue personnel arrived on the scene and pronounced both victims deceased.

Currently there are no suspect(s) in custody. Details are limited in this investigation.
