Homicide Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department is conducting a homicide investigation. The incident occurred on Sunday, July 31, 2022.

The victim has been identified as:

Robert Benard Lewis, (22), B/M, of Birmingham, Alabama.

At approximately 2:25 AM, North Precinct officers were dispatched to the 1800 Block of 15th Avenue North on report of a person down. Officers arrived on the scene and observed the victim lying responsive on the ground suffering from an apparent gunshot wound.

Birmingham Fire and Rescue personnel arrived on the scene and pronounced the victim deceased.

Details are limited in this investigation. Currently, there is no one in custody.
