## **Robbery Investigation**

The Birmingham Police Department reports detectives are conducting a robbery investigation. Detectives requests assistance from the public in identifying a suspect in the attached photo.

On Sunday, November 20, 2022, an Amazon delivery was robbed while in the 1600 Block of 6<sup>th</sup> Street North. The suspect was armed with a handgun; he took the Amazon delivery van from the victim. The Amazon van has since been recovered; however, the suspect is still at large.
