Homicide Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department is conducting a shooting investigation. The incident occurred on Monday, December 5, 2022.

At approximately 3:22 PM, East Precinct officers were dispatched to the 700 Block of Springville Road, on report of multiple people shot.

Officers arrived on the scene and observed 3 adult males suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. While on the scene officers noted that one of the victims' injuries appeared to be life threatening. Birmingham Fire and Rescue Service personnel arrived on the scene and transported all victims to UAB Hospital.

The victim that was noted to have life threatening injuries succumbed to his injuries while at UAB Hospital.

Currently there are no suspects in custody.

FBI Uniform Crime Reporting guidelines do not require law enforcement agencies to include justifiable death investigations into the total homicide investigations counts.
