Homicide Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department is conducting a homicide investigation. The incident occurred on Friday, June 30, 2023.

The victim will be identified upon notification to next of kin.

At approximately 11:43 PM, North Precinct officers were responding to a call of a person shot in the 600 Block of 11th Court West.

Officers arrived on the scene and observed an adult female unresponsive, lying on the sidewalk suffering from a gunshot wound.

Birmingham Fire and Rescue arrived on the scene and pronounced the victim deceased.

The preliminary investigation suggests the victim was involved in an altercation that led to a gunshot being fired, wounding the victim.

This homicide is domestic in nature.

There is a person of interest detained at this time.

This is Birmingham's 60th murder investigation of 2023 with 5 justifiable death investigations. The Birmingham Police Department adheres to FBI Uniform Crime Reporting guidelines set for all law enforcement agencies across the United States. FBI Uniform Crime Reporting guidelines do not require law enforcement agencies to include justifiable death investigations in the total homicide investigations counts.

The information is based on a preliminary and ongoing investigation, which continues to evolve as investigators interview witnesses, review physical and electronic records, and analyze forensic evidence. The Department's understanding of the facts and circumstances may change as additional evidence is collected and analyzed
