## **Double Homicide Investigation**

The Birmingham Police Department is conducting a double homicide investigation. The incident occurred on **Sunday, October 15, 2023**.

The victims have been identified as:

- 1. Jacquic Little, (24), B/F, of Birmingham, Alabama
- 2. Damon Thomas, (28), B/M, of Fairfield, Alabama.

At approximately 2:28 a.m., West Precinct officers were dispatched to a ShotSpotter alert in the 1800 Block of Fulton Avenue Southwest. Officers were updated that a male was shot at a residence.

Officers arrived on the scene and then entered the residence when they discovered both victims inside suffering from an apparent gunshot wound.

Birmingham Fire and Rescue personnel arrived on the scene and pronounced both victims deceased.

Details are limited in this investigation.

There is no one in custody.
