Arrest Made in the Roebuck Walmart Shooting Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department reports detectives have obtained a warrant for an arrest in connection to an Assault Investigation. The incident occurred on **Tuesday, December 5, 2023**, at the Roebuck Walmart (9248 Parkway East).

Just after 1:30 p.m., East Precinct officers were dispatched to a Person Shot call at the Roebuck Walmart.

Officers arrived on the scene and then located an adult male inside the store who was suffering from a gunshot wound.

Two Birmingham officers, who were at Walmart for a community event, took the suspected shooter into custody just outside the store.

Birmingham Fire and Rescue personnel arrived on the scene and transported the victim to UAB Hospital with life-threatening injuries.

Officers transported the suspect to BPD Headquarters for questioning by BPD Felony Assault detectives; he was then transported to the Birmingham City Jail and placed under a 48-Hour Felony Extension.

Birmingham Police Detectives presented information on the case to the Jefferson County District Attorney's Office. After an assessment of the information, detectives obtained an arrest warrant for **Assault 1st Degree**.

The suspect has been identified as:
Tywonte Jackson, (25), B/M, of Center Point, Alabama.

On Wednesday, December 6, 2023, Tywonte Jackson was booked into the Jefferson County Jail under a **\$30,000 Bond**.

Note: The victim and suspect knew each other.
