Homicide Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department is conducting a homicide investigation. The incident occurred on **Saturday, March 9, 2024**.

The victim has been identified as: Lamar King, (41), B/M, of Birmingham, Alabama.

At approximately 2:20 a.m., West Precinct officers were dispatched to a Person Shot call at 701 Princeton Avenue SW (Princeton Baptist Medical Center).

When officers arrived at the location, they observed the victim unresponsive, suffering from an apparent gunshot wound.

The victim was pronounced deceased shortly after arrival by medical personnel.

The preliminary investigation suggests that the victim was dropped off at the Hospital by private vehicle. The location of where the shooting occurred is undetermined at this time.

There is no one in custody.

This is Birmingham's 18th murder investigation of 2024 with 3 justifiable death investigations.

The Birmingham Police Department adheres to FBI Uniform Crime Reporting guidelines set for all law enforcement agencies across the United States. FBI Uniform Crime Reporting guidelines do not require law enforcement agencies to include justifiable death investigations in the total homicide investigations counts.

The information is based on a preliminary and ongoing investigation, which continues to evolve as investigators interview witnesses, review physical and electronic records, and analyze forensic evidence. The Department's understanding of the facts and circumstances may change as additional evidence is collected and analyzed
