Homicide Investigation

The Birmingham Police Department is conducting a homicide investigation. The incident occurred on **Sunday, March 10, 2024**.

The victim will be identified upon notification to the next of kin.

At approximately 8:57 a.m., East Precinct officers were dispatched to a Person Shot call in the 2300 Block of 7th Way NW, Madison Park Apartments.

When officers arrived on the scene, they observed the victim lying on the sidewalk unresponsive, suffering from an apparent gunshot wound.

Birmingham Fire and Rescue Services arrived on the scene and transported the victim to UAB Hospital.

The victim was pronounced deceased shortly after arrival by medical personnel.

The preliminary investigation suggests that the victim and suspect were involved in a confrontation inside an apartment. The victim was struck by gunfire before exiting the apartment and collapsing on the sidewalk.

There is a person of interest detained.

This is Birmingham's 19th murder investigation of 2024 with 3 justifiable death investigations.
