## **Homicide Investigation**

The Birmingham Police Department is conducting a homicide investigation. The incident occurred on **Monday, March 11, 2024**.

**The victim will be identified upon notification to the next of kin.**

At approximately 4:53 p.m., South Precinct officers were responding to a Person Shot call in the 10 Block of 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue SW, the Titusville Community.

When officers arrived on the scene, they observed the victim lying on the ground unresponsive, suffering from an apparent gunshot wound.

Birmingham Fire and Rescue Services arrived on the scene and pronounced the victim deceased.

The preliminary investigation suggests that the victim was standing outside with other community members when the suspect, wearing a ski mask, began firing shots striking the victim. The suspect left the scene.

No one else was injured.

There is a no one in custody.

This is Birmingham's **20th** murder investigation of 2024 with **3** justifiable death investigations.
