Birmingham Firefighters Discover Two Bodies in Burning Vehicle

The Birmingham Police Department is conducting two unclassified death investigations. The incident occurred on **Tuesday, October 29, 2024**.

The victims will be identified by the Jefferson County Coroner's Office.

Just before 8 a.m., Birmingham Fire and Rescue Service (BFRS) personnel were dispatched to a Fire call in the 1600 Block of the 89th Place North.

BFRS personnel arrived and extinguished the flames; they discovered two victims inside the vehicle burned.

BPD Homicide detectives are investigating the deaths as unclassified death investigations. ATF agents are assisting BPD detectives.

The Jefferson County Medical Examiner's Office will perform an autopsy on the victims to determine their identities, the cause of death, and the manner of death.
